

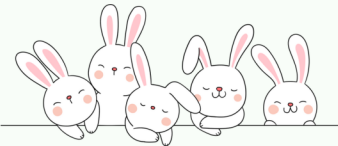
## STEP 7:

Glue the ears securely to the top of the narrow point of the egg. Pull some cotton and glue it around the bottom of the ears to cover the glue.



## STEP 8:

Glue a cotton ball on the lower back for a tail.

## EASTER BUNNY EGGS

## INSTRUCTIONS:

### STEP 1:

Hold your egg so that one end is facing up. Place a dollop of glue in the center of the top of the egg. Attach one end of your yarn to the glue.



### STEP 2:

Attach one end of your yarn to the glue. Roll your yarn into a half circle, add another dab of glue, and adhere it to the glue.



### STEP 3:

Continue wrapping the yarn in a circular motion around the egg, adding glue to adhere it as you go.



### STEP 4:

When you reach the other end of your egg, complete the final semi-circle and secure the yarn with glue.




### STEP 5:

Cut out your paper bunny ears, making sure you leave the line at the bottom. This will make it easier to attach them to the egg.



### STEP 6:



Pull cotton from one cotton ball and stretch it to fill the back of one ear. Do the same for the second ear. When you like the way they look, glue them down.



### STEP 6:

Flip the ears over and pull cotton again, but just cover the inside of the front of the ears, leaving the pink edge showing. When you like the look of the cotton, glue it down. You can also trim the cotton on the front and back after it is glued down to refine the look.
