

- (1) 6 x 6 Wood Square with pre-drilled hole
- (1) 4 x 4 Wood Square
- (1) 4 x 4 Wood Square with pre-drilled hole
- (1) 3-inch Craft Square
- (1) Length of Rope
- (2) Cable Clips
- (2) 3 x 3 Landscapes



- Hot Glue Gun
- Hot Glue Sticks
- (1) 3 x 3 photo
- (Optional) Craft Paints



While we create a frame using unpainted wood, you are encouraged to use craft paint to customize your frame with colors to fit your style! You could create a monochrome effect, use complementary colors, or go for contrast!



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DIY Mini Decorative Photo Frames









Step 1A (Optional)

Paint each wood square. Wait for squares to completely dry before moving onto the next step.



Step 1B

Lay the blank 4 x 4 wood square (square A) flat. Secure the cable clips to each side so that they are in the middle and flush to each side. Add the craft square to ensure it fits correctly.





Step 2

Peel the protective tape from the back of each cable clip.



Step 3

Lay the 4 x 4 wood square with the drilled hole square B), so that the hole is at the top and it forms a diamond shape.



Step 4

Place square A on top of square B so that the cable clips run parallel to the top hole. Secure square A to square B. Consider adding hot glue between the wood squares to ensure they stay attached.





Step 5

Lay the 6 x 6 wood square (square c) on a flat surface with the predrilled hole at the top.



Step 6

Line up the hole in square A with the hole in square C. Glue the two squares together.







Step 7

Loop your rope through the top hole to create a way to hang your frame. Glue it in place, if necessary.
