# INSTRUCTIONS

## STEP 1:

Take your cotton ball and pull them into small thinner piece. Begin to tuck the cotton into the open spaces of the pine cone.



## STEP 2:

Bend the tan pipe cleaners to form three triangular toes. Attach the feet with hot glue to the base of the cone.



## STEP 3:

Bend the yellow pipe cleaner to make the beak. Cut a hour glass shape from the gold felt. Attach wiggly eyes to the felt. Glue to the pine cone.



Using the pattern, cut wings 1 and 2. Glue onto the sides of your pinecone..



## STEP 5:

You may need to adjust the pipe cleaner feet so your owl sits straight.
