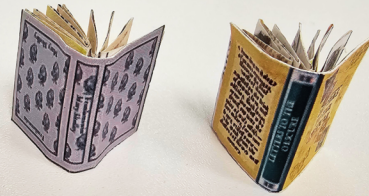

SUPPLIES PROVIDED:

- Book Covers on Cardstock
- Book inserts
- Glue Stick



SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Scissors or Utility/Hobby Knife and Cutting Mat
- Straight Edge for Precision Folding (Metal Ruler)

Optional Supplies:

- Modge Podge or Craft/Elmer's Glue
- Old Paint Brush

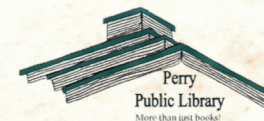


MINI BOOK COLLECTION

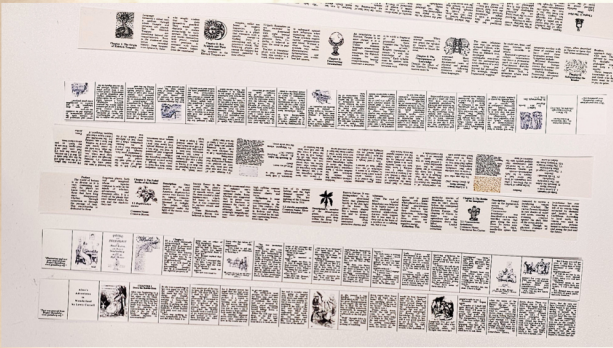
Learn how to create your own Mini Book Collection to use for a variety of art or decorative projects!



INSTRUCTIONS:

STEP 1:

Cut out your book covers and inside pages. This can be done with scissors. If you would like cleaner edges, you can use a utility or hobby knife to cut and a metal ruler.



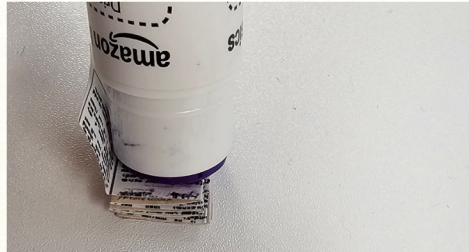
STEP 2:

Fold the inside pages accordion style along the lines. If you want precision folds, you can use the edge of a metal ruler.



STEP 3:

Glue the folded pages together. (Stick glue can work well to not wrinkle the pages, but you can use craft glue).



STEP 4 (OPTIONAL):

For a glossier look, consider applying glue or Modge Podge to the outside of the book covers. Allow them to dry before moving on to the next step.



STEP 5:

Wrap the cover around the pages to make sure everything is aligned.



STEP 6:

Add glue to attach the cover to the first and last page of your insert. You can use stick or craft glue.
