EGGS To ACORNS




UPCYCLED EGGS

INSTRUCTIONS STEP 1:

Lay material wrong side up. Glue the wide part of your egg to the center of material square.



STEP 2:

Gather and fold one side of material and glue to egg. Gather and fold material from opposite side and continue gluing until all four sides are glued.



STEP 3

Trim off extra material from top of egg. Begin attaching twine to egg with a small dot of glue. Starting on the cut line of the material begin wrapping twine around the egg.



STEP 5:

Continue working twine around the egg. Using a small amount of glue. Keeping the twine tight and close to each other.



STEP 6

Attach a cut toothpick with a drop of hot glue. Use a brown Sharpie to color your toothpick.
