FELT FLOWERS

INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1:

Fold and glue one strip longways to make a tube.



STEP 2:

Time to cut. On the non glued side, cut small slits about a third of an inch apart. DON'T CUT ALL THE WAY THROUGH THE TUBE!



STEP 3:

Begin to roll and glue the strip together, Forming your felt flower. Every so, often add another dot of glue to hold the flower together. When you reach the end of the roll, make sure you secure the end tightly.



STEP 4:

When you reach the end of your tube, secure with glue. With the green felt squares make your leaves. Glue on the green leaf to you flower.





Step 5:

Poke the green floral wire to the underside of the middle of your flower.

Step 6:

Place the white styrofoam piece in the bottom of the jar. Poke flowers into the foam. Add the greenery and rocks to the arrangement. Finish with ribbon accent.
