

- (1) Red Pony Bead
- (1) Yellow Pony Bead
- (2) White Pony Beads
- (1) Green Cube Bead
- (5) Assorted Round Beads
- (1) Needle
- (2 ft) Green Ribbon
- 100% Nylon Thread



- Scissors
- (Optional) Binder Clips



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## Step 7

Loop your thread through the yellow bead and the top ribbon multiple times. When it is secure enough, make a loop at the top and tie a knot to create a way to hang your ornament.

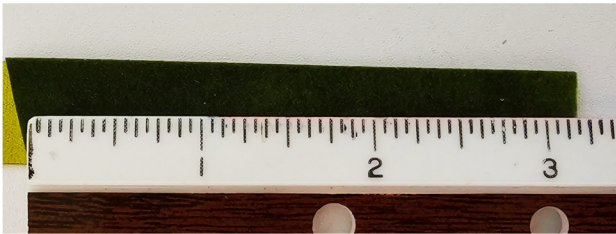
## November DIY Ribbon Trees



# INSTRUCTIONS

## 1 Step 1

Lay your ribbon flat, with the short, green side down. Fold at about 3 ¼ inches. Fold on the other side, creating two firm creases.



## 2 Step 2

Using the long end of the ribbon, continue folding the ribbon, gradually shortening the lengths as you go, until you have six folds.



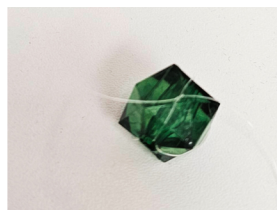
## 3 Step 3

Once your folds are completed, make sure they are secure. One good idea is to add binder clips to hold them in place until you need to use the ribbon.



## 4 Step 4

Loop your thread through your needle. Wrap the thread through the hole in the square bead multiple times, pulling tightly. Leave enough of a tail to tie a couple of knots at the bottom to secure it.



## 5 Step 5

Loop your thread through the first layer of folded ribbon. Drop one pony bead, then one multi-colored bead on the thread on top of the ribbon.



## 6 Step 6

Continue repeating pattern from Step 5 until you reach the top of your tree. String your yellow pony bead at the top of the tree.
