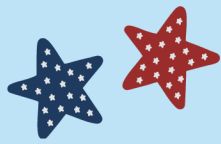


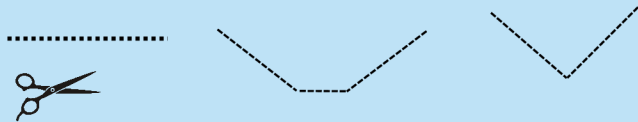
STEP 11:

Repeat Steps 6 through 8.



STEP 12:

You have a few options at this point for the style. You can trim straight across, angled, or in a "V" Shape. Adjust length as desired.



To create the tassel look in the example, unravel the rope threads of the tassels by twisting them. You can also comb them.

- 41 feet of Macrame Cord
- 5 Red Beads
- 5 Blue Beads
- 1 Wooden Dowel Rod

INSTRUCTIONS:

PART I:

STEP 1:

Cut 27 lengths of 18" inch cords



STEP 2:

Set 1 cord aside to be your hanging cord.
Divide the other cords into 13 sets of 2.



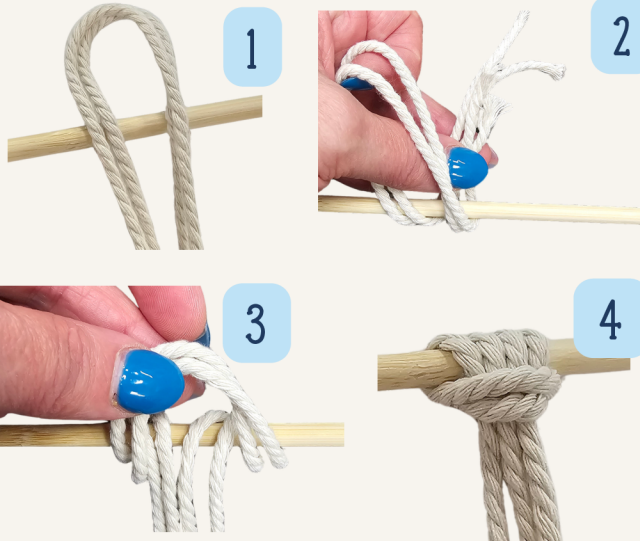
STEP 3:

Take 1 bundle of cords and fold it in half.



STEP 4:

Center your folded bundle on top of your wooden dowel. Put the bundle ends up through the loop and over the dowel. Pull down and secure into position. You now have your first tassel.



STEP 5:

Repeat Step 4 for remaining 12 bundles.



PART II:

Attach your beads to create an alternating red, white, and blue pattern that will help secure your tassels into place.

STEP 6:

1st choose a center rope strand from your first tassel. Slip the red bead up to the top. Tie a knot below the bead.

STEP 7:

Go to the next tassel. Pull out the middle rope and tie a knot in it.

STEP 8:

Go to the 3rd tassel. Slip a red bead to the top of the center rope. Tie a knot. Slip the blue bead up. Tie a knot.



STEP 9:

For the middle tassel, pull the center rope out. Add a red bead, tie a knot underneath, add a blue bead, then tie a knot underneath.

STEP 10:

Repeat Steps 6 through 8.
