

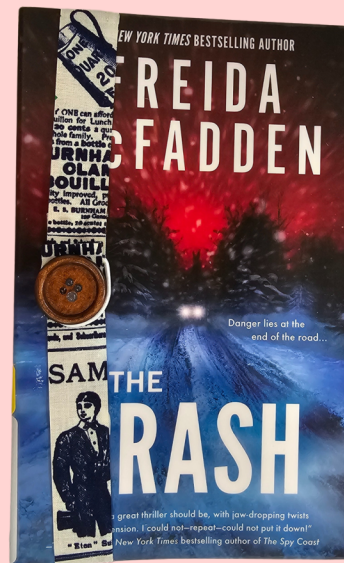
SUPPLIES PROVIDED

- (1) 24 inch cut of lace ribbon
- (2) buttons
- (2) hair bands

- Hot Glue Gun
- Hot Glue Sticks
- Craft Scissors
- Ruler/Tape Measure
- Sewing Pins
- Glue Alternative: Sewing needle & thread

DIY NO-SEW ADJUSTABLE RIBBON BOOKMARKS

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1: Measure the Ribbon

To measure the length of your books, you'll need a tape measure. 18 inches is a standard book size. Measure from the top of the book to the bottom.

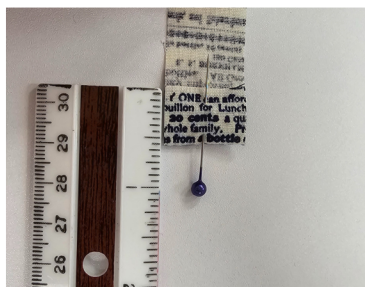


Step 2: Cut the Ribbon

Cut the ribbon based on your measurement.

Step 3: Measure and Pin

Go to one end of the ribbon and fold the edge over to 2 inches. Place a pin to hold it down.



Step 5: Glue the Edges

Glue down the edges. Once secure, remove the pin.

Step 6: Measure and Pin

Go to the other end of the ribbon and fold the edge over to 2 inches. Place a hair band inside. Pin the ribbon in place.



Step 7: Glue the Edges

Glue down the edges. Once secure, remove the pin.

Note:

If you are comfortable with hand sewing, you can easily secure the ribbon and button with thread. This will provide a nice, glue-free, secure hold and more refined look to your project.



Step 7: Button Placement

Place both sides of your ribbon together and pull the band across. Mark the spot where you will place your button.



Step 7: Glue Button

Put glue on your button and secure to the side of your ribbon across from the band.



Step 7: Mark Your Page

Once the glue is fully dry, place the ribbon around your book to save your spot! Pull the elastic around the button to secure in place.
