

Borrowing Privileges

The Library provides free access to library materials reflecting the Library Bill of Rights and a Freedom to Read statement. See Appendix A. It is the parents' responsibility to monitor their children's selections.

Library borrowing privileges will be suspended if fines, damages, fees, or assessments for lost materials in excess of \$5.00 are not paid.

All library materials and equipment that have been damaged beyond reasonable and normal wear shall be paid for by the patron. The charge will be determined by the amount of damage.

If library materials and equipment are lost, the patron will be charged the list price plus processing fees.

Under certain conditions, teachers may borrow on their card for thirty days for classroom use and shall be responsible for the materials.
